Dear Sacred Heart Family,

Thanks to the hard work of so many in the parish, our Spring Church dinner last Sunday was a great success! I would like to thank all who helped coordinate this event – Charles Beaver, overall chairman, Mary Ann Hayden and Mary Jo Thompson, chairwomen of the kitchen, Tammy Pilkerton, chairwoman of the dining room, Ronnie and Melinda Lyon (and family), chair-man and –woman of the raffle, Patrick Goode, chairman for the carry-outs, Malcolm Goode, head of the parking lot, Debbie Johnson and Joan Farr who headed up the country store, and Mary Beaver who was in charge of the cake table. But they could not have done it without the help of so many in the parish who sacrificed their time during the week to pull this off. I deeply appreciate all you did to support this important fundraiser for the parish. What a wonderful parish community we have!

Starting this Sunday, the Catholic cable channel, EWTN, begins its 8-part series entitled: *Catholic Beginnings: Maryland*. This series, which will be shown at 6:30pm every night from July 3-9, (with an encore later each night at 2:30am), was filmed on location at St. Clement's Island, St. Mary's City, St. Inigoes, St. Francis Xavier and its Manor, St. Ignatius Church at Chapel Point, and the Carmel monastery at Port Tobacco. It is appropriate that this series begins on the 4<sup>th</sup> of July weekend. It reminds us that the Catholic faith pre-dates the formation of our country, and that our government has the responsibility to safeguard our religious freedom – this freedom predates the United States and in fact it predates every government. Pope Francis in his address to the U.S. Congress last September, told our nation's representatives: "You are called to defend and preserve the dignity of your fellow citizens in the tireless and demanding pursuit of the common good, for this is the chief aim of all politics... you are asked to protect, by means of the law, the image and likeness fashioned by God on every human face." Thomas Jefferson, who wrote our Declaration of Independence, also wrote these words – they can be found today on his memorial in Washington, D.C.: "No man shall be compelled to frequent or support any religious worship or ministry or shall otherwise suffer on account of his religious opinions or belief, but all men shall be free to profess and by argument to maintain, their opinions in matters of religion." These are all words to remember as we celebrate the roots of our Catholic faith on these shores, as we celebrate the beginnings of the United States, and as we remember our inalienable right to openly practice our faith in our country.
