This upcoming week, we will be celebrating All Saints Day (Thurs, Nov 1), which is a Holy Day of Obligation. There will be plenty of opportunities in the 7<sup>th</sup> District to attend Mass. We will have a Vigil Mass on **Wednesday, October 31<sup>st</sup> at 4pm at Sacred Heart**. This should allow for plenty of time to get back home for trick-or-treating. There will be 3 Masses celebrated on **Thursday, November 1<sup>st</sup>**. The first one will be at **7:30am at Holy Angels**. The second Mass will be at **12pm at Sacred Heart**. While All Souls Day is not a Holy Day of Obligation, it is a special day where we remember our beloved faithful departed and pray for the repose of their souls. Since All Souls Day lands on a First Friday, we will have our usual First Friday Mass schedule with Mass at Sacred Heart at 7am and 11am. Prior to the 11am Mass, there will be Eucharistic Adoration and Confessions beginning at 10am with Benediction leading up to the start of Mass.

Lastly, do not forget to change your clocks! Next Sunday, November 4<sup>th</sup> is the end of Daylight Savings Time. So, we will "gain" an extra hour of sleep since we will turn our clocks back 1 hour.
