Thank you to those who picked and washed the kale, cooked the turkey breasts, crumbled countless loaves of bread for the stuffing, folded over 1,000 boxes for the cake table and carry-outs, stuffed the hams and cooked and cooled them, sliced the turkey and hams, packaged all of the Ziploc bags with the different food, peeled and eyed pounds and pounds of potatoes, cooked them, sliced the cabbage, mixed the cole slaw, packaged all of the containers with stuffing and potatoes, baked cakes, contacted everyone in the parish to bake cakes, washed all of the dishes, set up the buffet table, set up the plates and silverware for the dining room, cooked and packaged the green beans, fried the oysters, seated people in the dining room, transferred the food from the kitchen to the dining room, packaged all of the carry-out dinners, safeguarded and counted the money, sold raffle tickets, and came back the next day to set the hall straight. And a special thank you to those who did a particular job, but somehow didn't get included in the litany of jobs.

Thank you again so much for all of the time you spent in making this dinner a success. I really enjoyed my first dinner and I had a lot of fun stuffing the hams (and eating them too)! I look forward to our Annual June Dinner and I know that will be a huge success as well.
